Happy Holy Week! It may seem like a contradiction of terms to call it "happy," just like when we say "Happy Lent." But, this is the greatest happiness there can be. At the Easter Vigil this Saturday night, some of you may hear "O happy fault that earned so great, so glorious a Redeemer!" Through this, God shows us a happiness that can only come from a power far beyond us. It is the power of redemption brought about through the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ. And it all plays out this week.

- 4 days: 6:30 pm Holy Thursday multilingual Mass of the Lord's Supper with the washing of feet available to all (just one foot to be washed per person)
8:30 or 9 pm: adoration at the altar of repose available until 12 midnight
- 5 days: Good Friday: a required day of fasting and abstinence; no CLS talk this week
9:45 am 8th Grade re-enactment of the Lord's Passion
3:00 pm multilingual Stations of the Cross
6:30 pm multilingual Good Friday Service
- 6 days: Holy Saturday (NO Mass permitted before the Easter Vigil)
8:45 pm Easter Vigil Mass
- Next Sunday: **the Solemnity of Easter!**

FAITH IN ACTION NOTES

March 29, 2026

Palm Sunday - Lent A



Faith in Action: Each year on Palm Sunday, we hear the account of our Lord's Passion and death from a different Evangelist. The account from The Gospel of Matthew may be overwhelming in its length, but it is important, as we begin Holy Week, to contemplate on the incredible

events that lead to our salvation. The reading from Matthew begins with the betrayal of Judas Iscariot. We might tend to cast Judas as the villain of the story. There must be someone to blame, right? In truth, we can see ourselves in the role of betrayer every time we refuse God's graces, love and mercy because of our own sin. We could see ourselves in the disciples who fell asleep, when they should have been praying. We can see ourselves like Peter, who declares that his faith in Jesus will never be shaken, yet, when faced with fear, Peter denies Jesus. At times, we are those who mock Jesus by taking His name in vain. When reading or hearing the Passion of our Lord, remember two things. First, by our sins and weakness of faith, we are the betrayers, the deniers, the lukewarm. Second, Jesus freely gave His life for each of us. Jesus sees our weaknesses and still offers His Body and Blood so that we might have eternal life with Him. Confess your sins, your failures, your moments of denial during this Holy Week. Look in the bulletin for Confession times.

Something to ponder: "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" These words are uttered by Jesus moments before He dies. The words are the beginning of Psalm 22. Ponder on this Psalm throughout Holy Week. The prayer begins in despair but ends in praise of God who never abandons us. It reminds us that the Kingship of Jesus will be over the entire world, and all peoples with sing His praises.

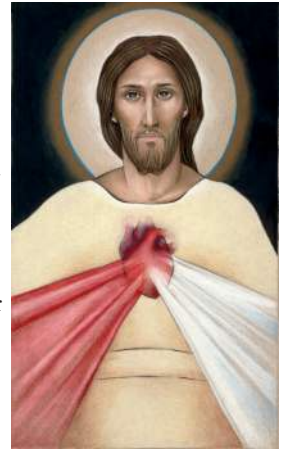
